On June 21 we received a call from Orlando Florida from the family of Carey Reams. He was in the hospital at that time and was to undergo surgery. He had a few things that he wanted to discuss with us as it was his feeling that he would not rise from his sick bed this time. Jim and Mary Jo Daily went down and spent a couple of days with him at that time and then later went to his bedside in Pennsylvania. Even now there is already speculation as to the cause of his death. We will attempt to set the record straight. On the death certificate the number one cause of death was overwhelming toxemia.

There were in fact a number of contributing factors in "Doc"s death. He had for some time been taking a number of persons into his home to help. The extent of his personal involvement in their care probably placed stress on his body at a time when he needed to conserve his strength. Also he was trying desperately to finish some projects that he had started to provide financial security for his wife and nine month old daughter. Also Doc had service connected disabilities that gave him maximum lifetime disability payments. This no doubt was also a factor. Without the health program that he developed, he probably would not have lived nearly as long as he did.

We all feel a great loss knowing that he is no longer there for us to take our questions to. His love and kindness will be missed. I hope that each and every one of us will try to pass on the love and knowledge that is the legacy of Carey Reams to the world.

The final projects that "Doc" was working on to provide for his family, he did not have time to complete. This has left his widow and nine month daughter in a difficult position. There has been set up a trust fund for the care of the daughter. Any contributions that any of you would care to make would be appreciated and would be a fitting way to show appreciation for all that Carey Reams has meant to so many of us.
